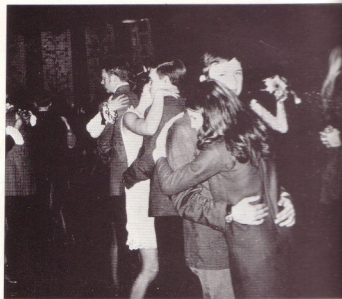

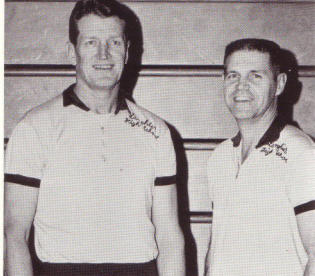

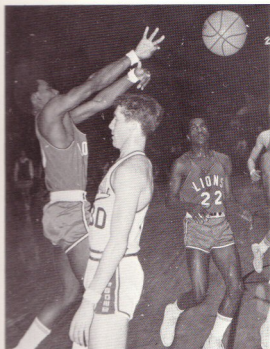
# Basketball

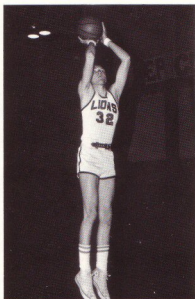
Finishing second in city and winning the regional, the Lanphier Lions were finally defeated in their second game of the sectional tournament by undefeated Lincoln.



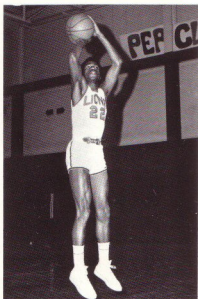
