Senior Dinner Dance\$23.00

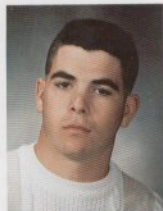

It all added up to quite an expense for graduating seniors, but most didn't seem to mind. They were happy to take advantage of the senior privileges that came along with it.

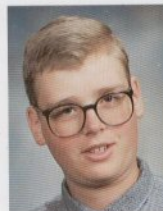
